

**Summer 2010 Paid Internship Program for SF Public High School Students  
July 6-July 30**

**The Power of Public Space: Create your neighborhood**

This paid internship will create public art, designs of public space, and a master plan for the Excelsior Neighborhood. This internship gives students the opportunity to work and make decisions like real world architects, urban planners and public artists. All of the design projects will not just remain "ideas", but will become real projects that will be installed and seen by the whole Excelsior community. We will be examining the Excelsior closely through tours and interviews with the people who live and work in the area. After getting to know the neighborhood and the community, we will propose potential public art designs for specific "hot spots" of public space. We will be learning how to make models and drawings to express our ideas on how to make the Excelsior neighborhood a better place. Finally, we will take our ideas and present them back to the community for their feedback. This class will be a combination of field trips out in the neighborhood and design time in the professional art studios. Upon completing the summer internship and all its requirements, students will receive a \$600 stipend.

Out of Site Summer Internship Program will run from July 6-July 30. Monday through Friday 9:30am-1:30pm. (1st class is on Tuesday July 6). Classes will be located at Out of Site Youth Arts Center located on the campus of Lick Wilmerding High School located next to Balboa Park BART/Muni. You can apply to be in the Summer Internship Program by filling out the attached form.

How to apply to be in the Summer Internship 2010 Program:

1. You must be between the ages of 14 and 17 and live or go to public high school in SF.
2. Ideal candidates are focused, community engaged and artistically inclined. Priority will be given to past OoS students and students who have participated in EAG projects.
3. Fill out paper application and fax or drop off no later than Monday May 17, 2010 @ 5pm.
4. Qualified applicants will be invited to come in for a group interview on Tuesday, June 1 at 4:30pm.

Note: We will accept 15-20 youth to participate in the 4-week program. All students will be paid a \$600 stipend on the last day of class as long as they fulfill all of the internship requirements.
